

Patient info:

- 56 years old
- Male
- Southeast Asian
- Medical hx: T2DM (A1C: 9.8%)

Hospital Course:

- Initially hypotensive
- Given IV fluids
- Preliminary blood culture results reveal the following microbiological features: Gram-negative rods, Facultative anaerobes, Non-motile, Lactose-fermenting, Indole-negative
- Started on empirical antibiotic therapy.
- Stabilized after IV fluids and abx
- A contrast-enhanced CT scan of the abdomen was ordered
- Imaging demonstrated a liver abscess
- Successful drainage by interventional radiology.
- General surgery and hepatology already consulted and involved
